Those entries received after said limit has been reached will be placed on an alternate (waiting) list according to postmarked date of received entry, and entrant will be notified of this. Pulling Big Rigs- Take US Rte 60 to State Rte 208 in Dresden to McLaughlin Hill Rd (left) and then right on Stone Church Road. This route consists of wider roads with lesser grades. **Alternate Routes-** Take State Rte 666 to State Rte 208 in Dresden to Stone Church Rd **OR** take State Rte 208 to Stone Church Rd.
